## STUDY VISITS TO LOCAL SCHOOLS

As a complement to the working sessions, the consortium conducted three study visits to schools in the city, providing us with an overview of the Spanish education system and its various models for preventing school dropout. At both Colegio Espinar and Colegio Ferroviario, we learned about the cooperative model of state-subsidized private schools. Finally, we visited Colegio Virgen del Carmen, one of the city's most prestigious schools, where we learned about its model of internationalization and support for students with special needs.
